Ofsted Inspection – 21 – 22 February 2018,

Following our recent inspection, I am pleased to enclose the summary of our inspection report, in accordance with section 14(1) of the Education Act 2005. The inspectors identified the Effectiveness of leadership and management as GOOD, Early years provision as GOOD and Personal development and welfare as GOOD.

- Leaders, including governors, have an accurate view of what the school needs to do to improve. They provide a broad and balanced curriculum which is relevant to pupils' lives.
- Provision for pupils' emotional, mental and physical well-being is strong. Parents and carer agree that pupils are well looked after.
- Children benefit from good teaching in the early years. This means that they make good progress from their starting points.

The inspectors identified the Quality of teaching, learning and assessment as Requires Improvement, Behaviour as Requires Improvement and Outcomes for pupils as Requires Improvement.

- Improve the quality and effectiveness of teaching as the quality of teaching across key stage 1 and key stage 2 is too variable.
- Improve outcomes in reading, writing and mathematics by the use of more effective questioning, higher expectations for the most able and ensure that pupils become more confident and resilient learners who persevere without seeking adult guidance.
- Improve pupils' ability to regulate their own behaviour so that they behave equally well with and without adult supervision.

The overall effectiveness of the school is Requires Improvement.

The governors and leaders of the school are confident that the areas for improvements identified will enable the school to continue to work towards achieving GOOD in all aspects at the next inspection.
