Introducing special friends - two letters one sound (have the children repeat this)



Teach the sound not letter name- 'nnnngggg'
Children copy you.
Say "a thing on a string", repeat a few times saying the sound and the picture phrase.



More confident readers

Children to practise reading the words with 'Fred in your head' (this means to sound it out in your head then read the word). Children should then be able to start reading the word without sounds. Say a word above and ask the children to point to the word.

s i n g

s o n g

w i n g

t h i n g

r i n g

k i n g

L o n g

b r i n g

Introducing a red word - remember 'you can't Fred a red' (you cannot sound out a red word you just have to remember it by saying it a few times and repeating every lesson as you build on the red words, gradually the children remember them).

Reading the simple sentence - children can use Fred talk to help them sound out the words and then keep reading the words until they become more confident. Ask children to point to a word as you say it to see if they can remember the words.
