Teach the sound not letter name- 'h,h,h,h,h,h' (bounce the sound).
Children copy you.

Say "down a horn up a horn and under his head", repeat a few times
saying the sound and the picture phrase.



Children practice (green words below) sounding out the letters (Fred talk) to blend into a word. For
example, y-e-t yet.

y u m

y a k

y e t

y e s

y u k

y i p

More confident readers

Children to practise reading the words with 'Fred in your head' (this means to sound it out in your head
then read the word). Children should then be able to start reading the word without sounds. Say a word
above and ask the children to point to the word.

Children practise writing the 'y' sound saying the phrase 'down a horn up a horn and under his head'.
