We could calculate all the answers by *counting on*,

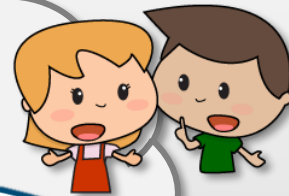
Here are my ideas...

We can use **doubles!**

Which of these can we solve using



$6 + 4$

We can use **number bonds to 10.**

$15 + 5$

We can use **pairs that make 20.**

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We can also use **place value** for some...  
remember how we use  
place value cards...



$10 + 6 = 16$

(a multiple of 10 + some  
1s)
