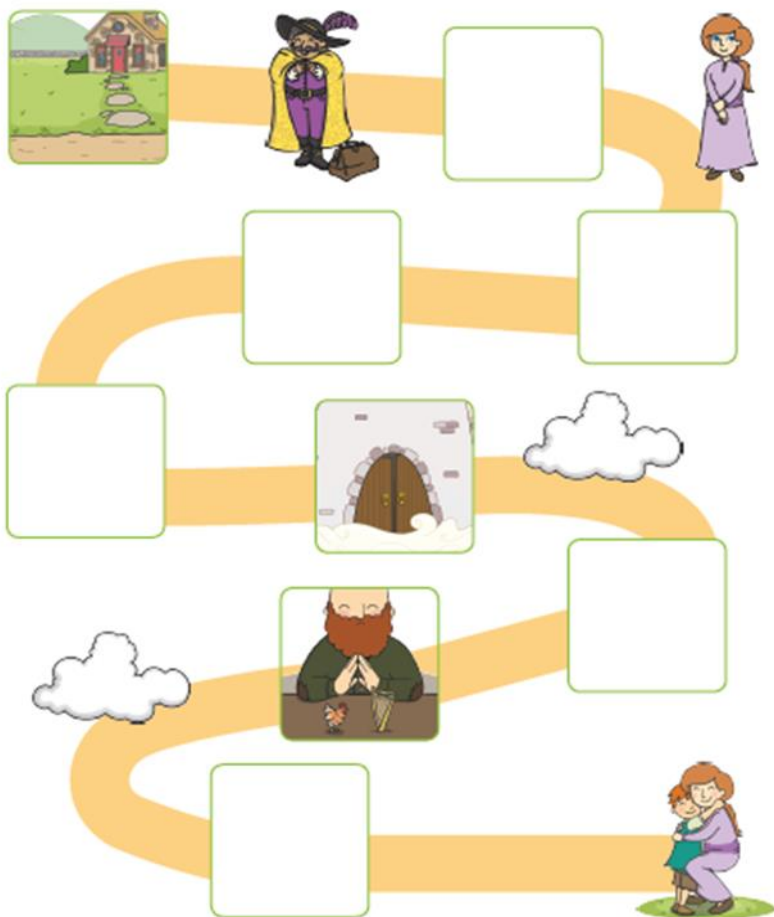




Activity 2

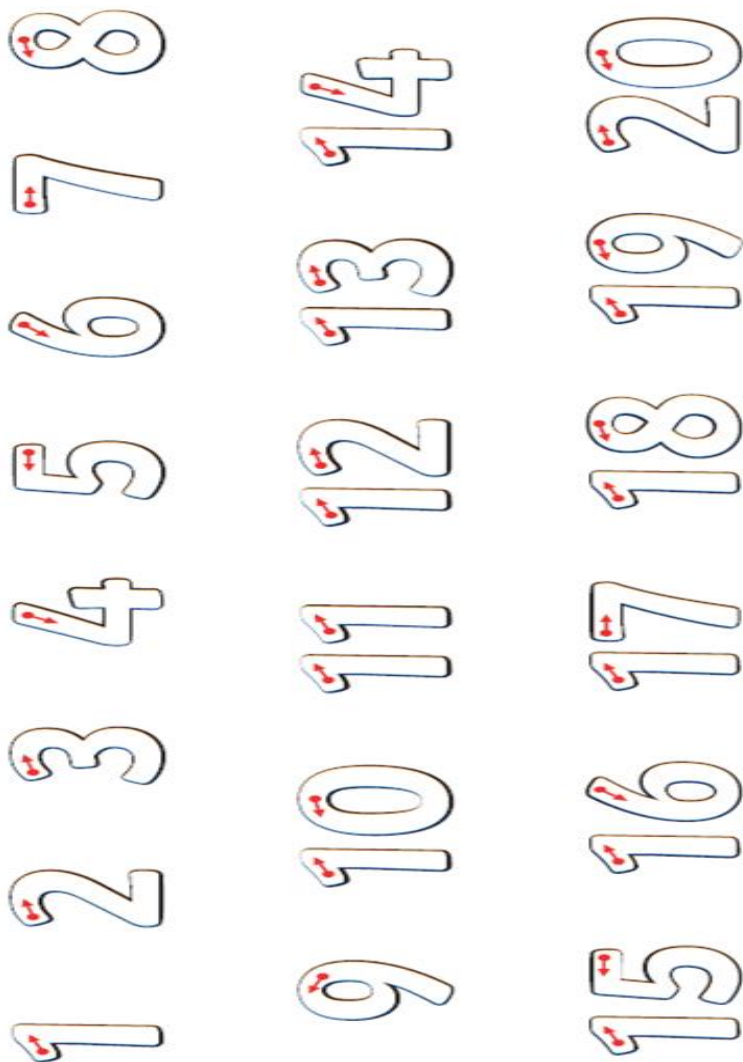
